Itinerary

Every Saturday morning the **Riverland Famers' Market** in Berri is a must, or visit the unique roadside fruit stalls just down the road on the Old Sturt Highway where you'll discover **Aggies Fruit Stall** adjacent to **Tony & Effie's Fruit Stall** with the in-season fruits of the Riverland — oranges, mandarins, butternuts, avocados and more. In Berri, head to **Pepperz** to purchase some local capers, or head to **Sprouts Café** for a local produce lunch and purchase their onion relish. On the way to Renmark stop in at the **Almondco Almond Hut** where you can try and buy various locally grown and produced almond products, or venture in to Renmark's main street to **Nuts About Fruit** and stock up on locally grown dried fruits, nuts and slices or head to **Jimmy's Fresh Fruit and Vegie Shed** for in season local produce. Finish with a wood fired pizza on the banks of the Murray at the **Renmark Club**, or dine at **Alpha's** overlooking the river from the balcony of the **Renmark Hotel**.
